I thought about this quite a while and decided that I can't be responsible for making this decision and so I am copying the entire board on this email in the hope that they will take this out of my hands and answer your request for Friends of Monte Rio.

You told me after the Board meeting tonight that FOMR wanted to book the Community Center on Saturday, July 6th for a Supper club event. At that moment I said "I don't see why not", but I have had time to reconsider and I don't really think this should be left up to me.

First of all, this community works all year towards this huge weekend. All of the small businesses count on this weekend as a major part of their annual income. The Monte Rio Chamber of Commerce plans the beach events and fireworks and the Monte Rio Fire District holds it's annual BBQ at the fire station on that Saturday and our beach concessionaire counts on this particular weekend to make a success of their summer. Our parking lots are completely full along with all the side streets and with the new addition (as of tonight) of the picnic concert at the amphitheater, this town is full to capacity. I think it would be inappropriate for FOMR to hold a supper club event on Saturday, July 6th that might distract from the efforts of all of these organizations as well as our towns businesses.

I therefore ask the MRRPD board to make this decision and let me know (again, by individual email back to me) if this event can be booked for FOMR.

Thank you for understanding my reasons for taking this to the board for action and I'd like to suggest that if FOMR wants to have an event that weekend, that Sunday, July 7th would be a better choice.
